ORDER

I have considered the praecipe and the affidavit both dated 26 November 2021 filed in support of the application together with the documents thereto annexed.

The applicant is seeking an interim order in the nature of an injunction-

- (i) maintaining the "status quo" quoad the membership of Cloud Innovation as a Resource Member in the Respondent;
- (ii) restraining and prohibiting the Respondent from unilaterally withdrawing and/or revoking in any manner whatsoever and/or giving effect in any manner whatsoever any decision to withdraw and/or revoke whether directly or indirectly its undertaking given before the Honourable Judge sitting in Chambers on 15th July 2021 in injunctive application bearing Serial No. 1040/2021.



The prayer sought under paragraph (i) is inextricably linked with that under paragraph (ii). As regards the prayer under paragraph (ii), it is apparent from Annex 17, attached to the affidavit in support of the application, that on 25 November 2021 Counsel appearing for the respondent stated that the undertaking given by his client is now withdrawn. In the circumstances, there is no raison d'être for the present application which is set aside purely and simply.
