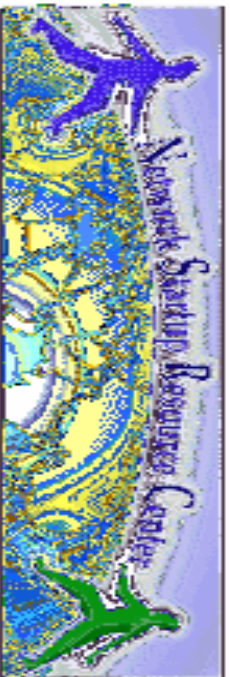

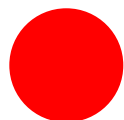

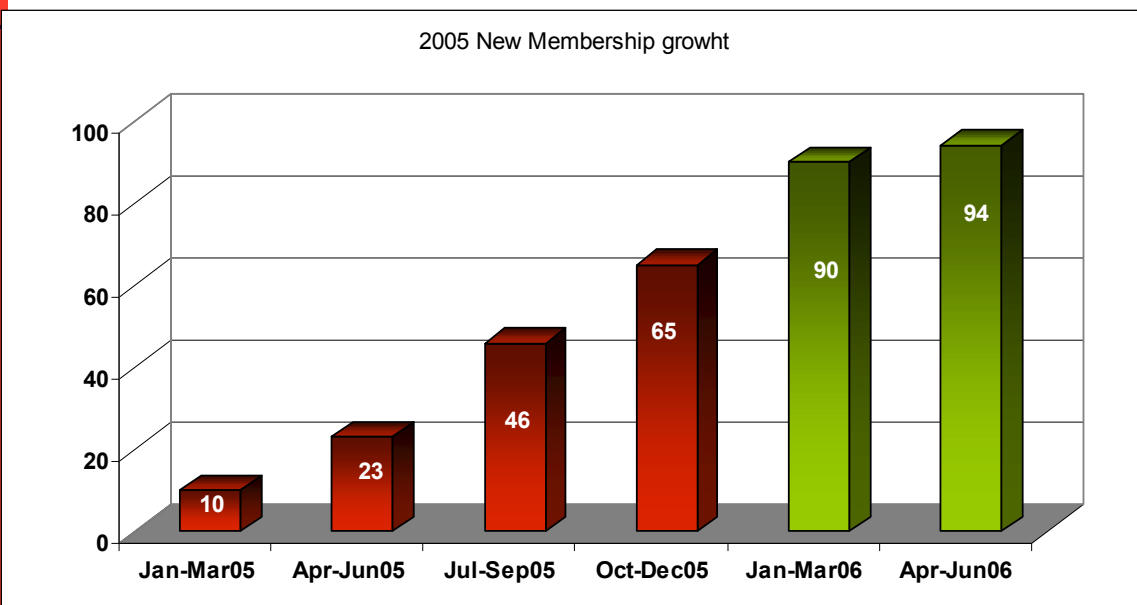


Services

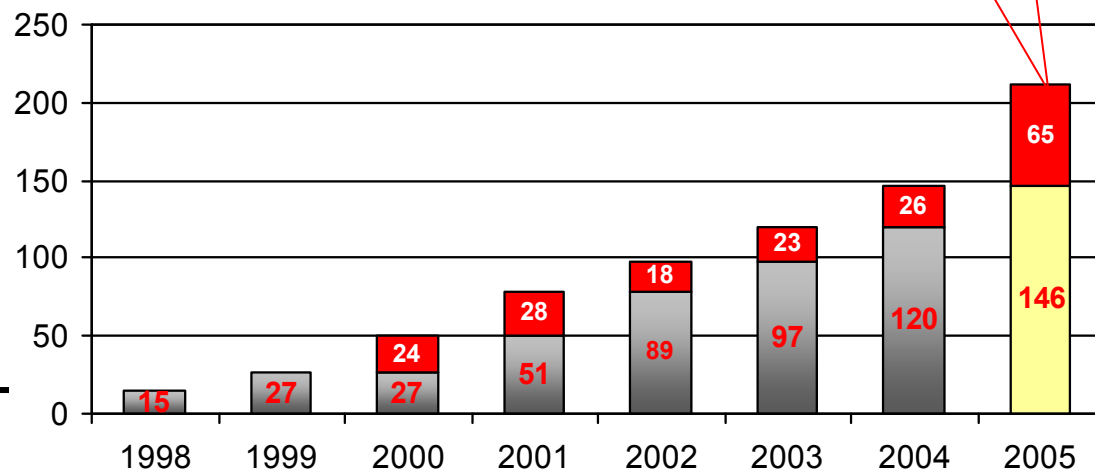
- We have all along the past year been focused on ensuring the continuity, with an acceptable service level.

140% growth

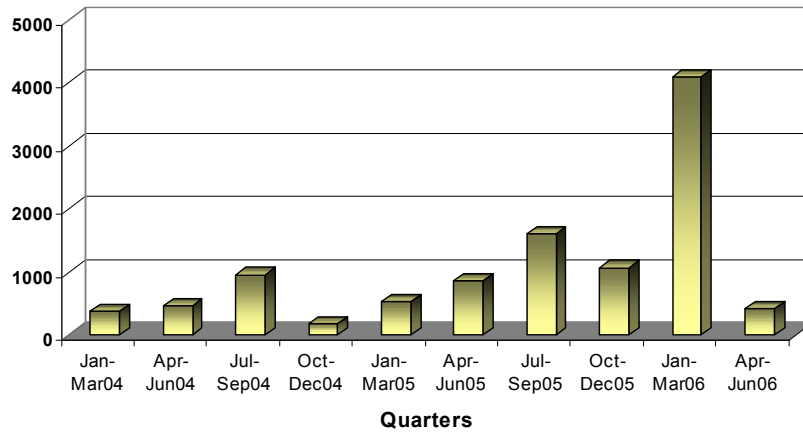

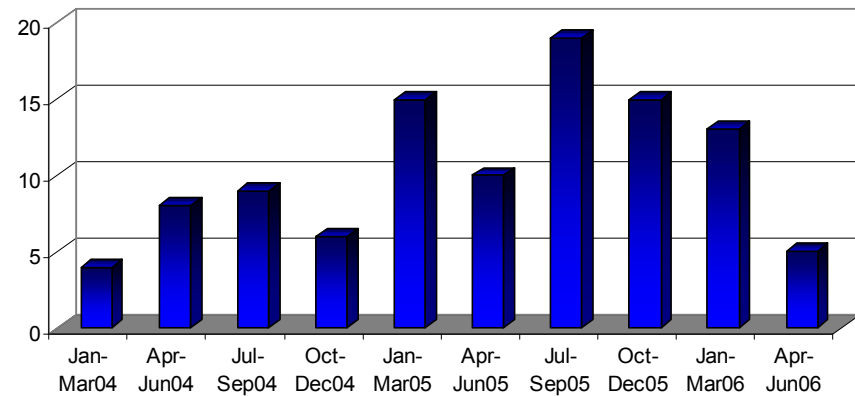
Growth in Resources allocation

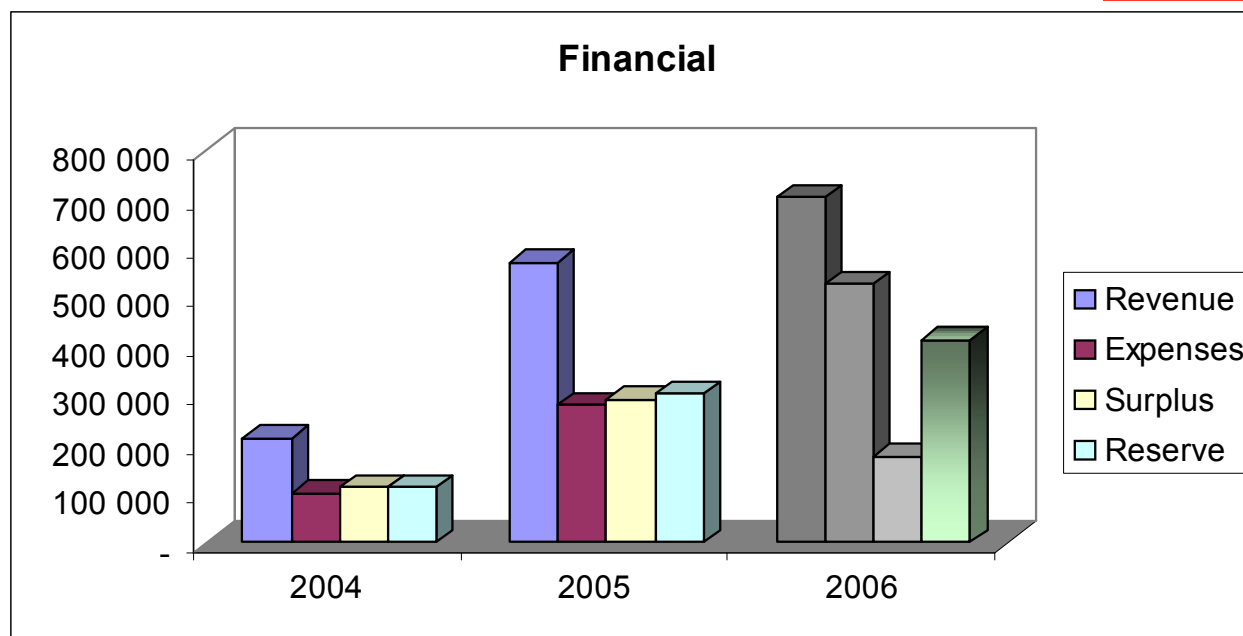




So...

- Afrinic has become a sector member of ITU-D to be able to better participate in Internet related discussions in our region and raise awareness among Policy makers.

 - *Afrinic identified as one of the ARAPKE projects partner*
 - *Represented the NRO at the ITU reform consultation meeting in Geneva*
 - *Participate to the WTDC meeting in Doha and participate to ITU-D WSIS follow up discussions*

Other projects

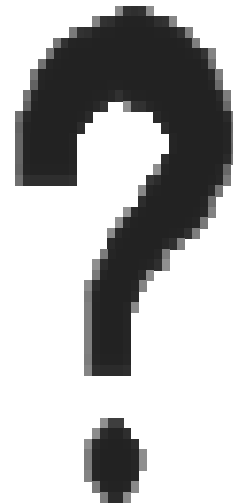
- Following a need expressed by the community in April 2005 (AfrinIC-2), we have been more active raising IPv6 awareness among our community. Beside the mailing list (afripv6-discuss) and the training program, we are looking for funding to implement a more complete IPv6 program (aka 6Mandela)
 - We had the first African IPv6 event in Cairo during AfrinIC-3 and expecting to have the second one during AfrinIC-5 (Next November)
 - AfrinIC (along with LACNIC and APNIC) has been invited to participate into a joint proposal for a 6-DISS2 project

- We have Participated to an inter-RIR workshop on Ressource Certification (RFC 3779), and will have further discussion on it during this meeting.



... what next?

- While it seems like things are moving, we still have some challenges facing us as organisation and as community:
 - Awareness and cooperation, a work still need to be done to toward policy maker on the continent.
 - Increase participation into our own policy development process
 - Strengthen the organization's structure to handle the growth efficiently
